<u>VACCINATION AND HEALTH POLICY:</u> In order to participate in boarding/daycare services all pets must be current on all of BPE's required medical services *prior* to staying. If your pet received vaccinations from a clinic other than Bayside Animal Hospital, <u>YOU</u> are responsible for having your records sent via e-mail or fax. All pets must be free of external parasites (fleas, ticks, etc) or they will be treated upon arrival at the owner's expense. We are unable to make any exceptions to our required vaccines or services unless a signed and dated letter is provided by your pet's veterinarian to medically exempt them from a specific requirement.

> **Dog Requirements:** Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, Bordetella (Kennel Cough), Influenza (Flu) **Cat Requirements:** Rabies, FVRCP (Upper Respiratory Complex)

<u>PLAYTIME POLICY</u>: While our staff enjoys having as many pets in group play as possible, please understand that playstyle evaluations are not guaranteed during your pet's stay with us. There's no timeline in which a playstyle evaluation will occur or be completed. Evaluation is based on *each individual pet's comfort level* with safety as a priority. Unspayed and unneutered pets will not be allowed to play with others.

<u>LEASHES AND COLLARS</u>: All pets are required to arrive and depart on a leash. We strongly discourage the use of retractable leashes. If you must use a retractable leash it needs to be locked with no more than 4 feet of length.

COURTESY While we take every precaution to avoid illness/ injury to our guests, accidents do happen! Should your pet develop any medical issues due to our boarding environment, our doctors at Bayside Animal Hospital will see them for a courtesy exam. This courtesy exam only covers medical issues caused by or due to our boarding environment. It does not cover pre-existing conditions that may flare up while your pet is boarding with us.

If there is an emergency that requires immediate attention your pet will be treated immediately and you will be responsible for all related charges. For other incidents that are not emergent, our vet staff will contact you first for approval prior to performing treatment(s).

The boarding of animals is subject to Article 3.1 of Chapter 27.4 of Title 3.2. If your pet becomes ill or is injured while in the custody of Bayside, Bayside shall provide the animal with emergency veterinary treatment for the illness or injury and the owner shall bear the reasonable and necessary cost of the emergency treatment.

The owner will pay a minimum of \$55 for the exam. If the veterinarian is called in after hours or on the weekend the emergency fee can range between \$100-\$300.

MEDICATION POLICY: All medications must come in their original, labeled packaging. We cannot accept medications in a pet's food or in any secondary packaging (ziploc bags, tupperware, etc). If you do not bring your pet's medication in the proper packaging, we will not be able to administer it while they are in our care. Over the counter supplements and vitamins must follow these same rules and regulations.

<u>ITEMS FROM HOME:</u> We will only accept up to 2 toys per pet to ensure they are not misplaced. We provide elevated Kuranda® beds. You will be charged a \$100 replacement should your pet destroy it. Feel free to bring your dog's WASHABLE bed or blanket from home for them to enjoy during their stay.

FEEDING POLICY: If you are bringing your pet's food from home, it must be pre-bagged per feeding and labeled with your dog's FIRST and LAST name. This ensures that everyone is receiving the correct food and nothing is getting mixed up. We will not accept large bags of food or containers full of food. We are unable to store these items during your pet's stay.
